比賽主題：困境中的學與教

世界幼兒教育聯會－香港分會自九二年成立以來，一直秉承母會為幼兒謀求福祉的宗旨。我們致力聯繫各幼兒教育團體、老師以及從事研究工作的專家和學者，匯聚成一股專業力量，推動香港幼兒教育邁向新里程。

本港幼稚園在數月間因種種事件多次停課，惟同工們努力不懈，以不同的創新教學方法，實踐「停課不停學」，是以本會第二屆「創新幼兒教學」大賽以「困境中的學與教」為主題，廣邀全港幼教同工享他們在這段時期的創新教學理念和方法。

我們希望通過本次比賽，鼓勵幼兒教師成為創新教學實踐的推動者，開發創新有效的教學法，促進幼兒的整體發展，同時提升自身的專業能力。我們亦會藉此建立創新教學資源平台，與本港業界分享各校優質創新的教學活動。

參賽資格

參賽者必須為

- 根據香港《幼兒服務條例》註冊的幼兒中心或根據香港《教育條例》註冊的幼稚園/幼稚園暨幼兒中心的教學人員；或
- 正就讀獲教育局認可幼兒教育職前培訓課程的學生。

每所幼兒機構可提交超過一個項目申請，不過，每項目團隊不可多於 4 位成員。

項目準則

有關創新教學項目必須：

- 是參賽者的原創作品，參賽者必須自行取得使用報告、圖像和影音的權限；
- 適用於 0-6 歲的幼兒；
- 符合《幼稚園教育課程指引》的核心價值和指導原則；
- 包括可在日常生活中找到或容易自行製作的教具；及
- 曾於停課或其他困境中有效實踐。

提交申請

參賽者必須提交以下資料：

- 申請表；
- 校長推薦書（幼兒機構參賽者）或導師推薦書（師訓課程學生參賽者）；
- 2 頁記錄有關項目理念、實施指引和實施過程的報告；
- 教學活動成功實踐的證明（例如：照片，短片等）。

上述資料必須於 **2020 年 4 月 18 日** 或之前呈交本會秘書處，逾期申請恕不受理。如檔案總大小小於 25MB，參賽者可以附件形式發送至本會電郵 omepksecretary@gmail.com。參賽者亦可把檔案上載雲端伺服器（例如：Google Drive, Dropbox, iCloud 等），並將直接鏈結發送到上述電郵地址，**請確保在提交申請時已給予我們下載資料的權限**。參賽者或需應要求提供 額外資料。

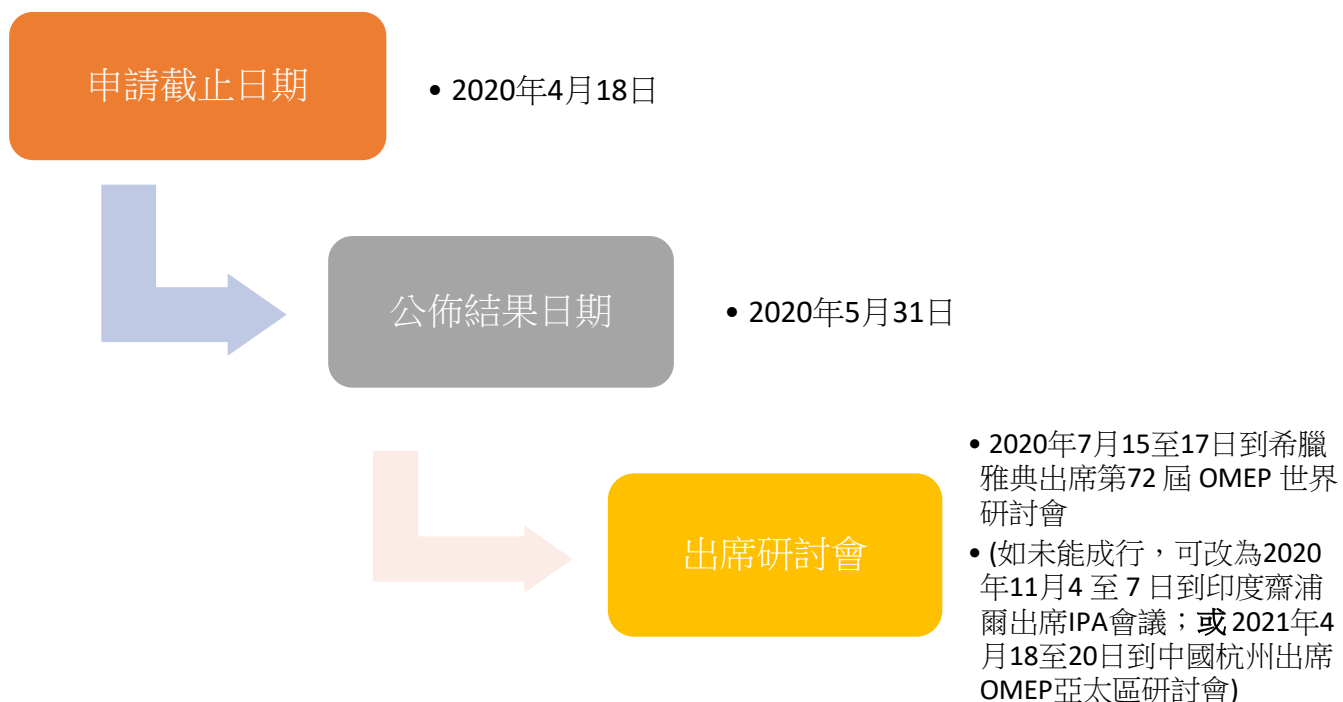

獎項

專家顧問將選出優秀的創新幼兒教學項目，得獎者將於 2020 年 5 月 31 日獲得通知。每一得獎團隊將可獲贊助（包括機票、住宿及研討會報名費）一位成員於 2020 年 7 月 15 至 17 日到希臘雅典出席第 72 屆 OMEP 世界研討會^(註)，向與會者展示和報告他們的創新教學理念和實踐。另外，本會亦會邀請得獎團隊在本地分享成果。

OMEP-Hong Kong The 2nd “Pedagogical Innovations in Early Childhood Education” Competition

Theme: Learning and Teaching during Difficult Times

The World Organization for Early Childhood Education (OMEP) is an international organisation committed to benefiting children, under the age of eight, throughout the world. The Hong Kong branch of this organisation was established in 1992. Our members are supervisors, teachers, academics and experts in the field of early childhood education, and we have a wide knowledge base in preschool education and care in Hong Kong.

The Hong Kong education sector is experiencing a prolonged and sector-wide class suspension due to various difficult circumstances. Nonetheless, early childhood educators have been working relentlessly to reinvent their curricula and pedagogies to continue the learning and teaching during this difficult time. With the theme of “Learning and Teaching during Difficult Times”, OMEP-Hong Kong invites all early childhood educators to take part in our second “Pedagogical Innovations in Early Childhood Education” competition and share their innovative pedagogies.

Through this competition, we encourage early childhood educators to act as inspiring agents to develop innovative and effective pedagogies to support the holistic development of young children, at the same time enhance their own professional learning and development. We also seek to create a database of innovative pedagogies that is useful for the early childhood community in Hong Kong.

Eligibility

We welcome applications from:

- early childhood educators who are currently working at local crèches and nurseries that are registered under the Child Care Services Ordinance of Hong Kong **or** kindergartens and kindergarten-cum-child-care-centres that are registered under the Education Ordinance of Hong Kong; **OR**
- tertiary students who are currently undertaking any pre-service training programmes on early childhood education that are approved by the Education Bureau.

There is not a limit for the number of applications an institution may submit. However, each project team should constitute not more than 4 members.

Project Criteria

Each project of pedagogical innovations should:

- be an original work of the applicant(s), with permission for the use of reports, images and audio/video recordings;
- be applicable for teaching children between the ages of 0 and 6 in Hong Kong;
- fulfill the core values and guiding principles of curriculum design as stated in the *Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide*;
- involve a set of teaching materials that can easily be made by teachers and children, or materials that can readily be found in daily life; and
- have been successfully implemented during class suspension or other difficult times.



Submission

A complete application includes:

- a complete application form; and
- Principal Nomination Form (for in-service early childhood educators) or Instructor Recommendation Form (for student teachers);
- a two-page report documenting the ideas, instructions, and implementation of the project;
- evidence demonstrating the activity has been carried out successfully (e.g., photos, videos, etc.).

All the above documents should be sent as attachments (if the total size is less than 25MB) to OMEP Hong Kong Secretariat at omephksecretary@gmail.com. Alternatively, applicants may upload the documents to a cloud server (e.g., Google Drive, Dropbox, iCloud, etc.) and send the direct link to the server to the above email address. **Please make sure you have given us permission to access the files by the time you submit your application.** Applicants may be required to provide additional information upon request.

The application deadline is **18 April 2020**. Late and/or incomplete application will not be accepted.

By submitting their application, it is assumed that the applicants agree to give OMEP-Hong Kong the copyrights and publication rights. Information on all the innovative pedagogy projects will be uploaded to OMEP-Hong Kong website at <http://www.omep.org.hk/>. These projects may also be featured in the future publications of OMEP-Hong Kong. In any case, the applicants will be properly acknowledged.

Awards

A panel of experts, academics, and educators will make their decisions based on the merits of the projects. The winning teams will be notified on 31 May 2020. Each of them will receive a travel award, which includes conference registration, airfare, and accommodation for one team member to attend the 72nd OMEP World Conference to be held in Athens, Greece between 15 and 17 July 2020*. The member shall prepare to present their innovative pedagogy project at the conference and at any related events organized by OMEP-Hong Kong.

*Due to the coronavirus outbreak, should the 72nd OMEP World Conference be postponed or cancelled, the winners will be invited to attend the International Play Association (IPA) Conference in Jaipur, India between 4 and 7 November 2020 **OR** the OMEP Asia-Pacific Regional Conference in Hangzhou, China between 18 and 20 April 2021.

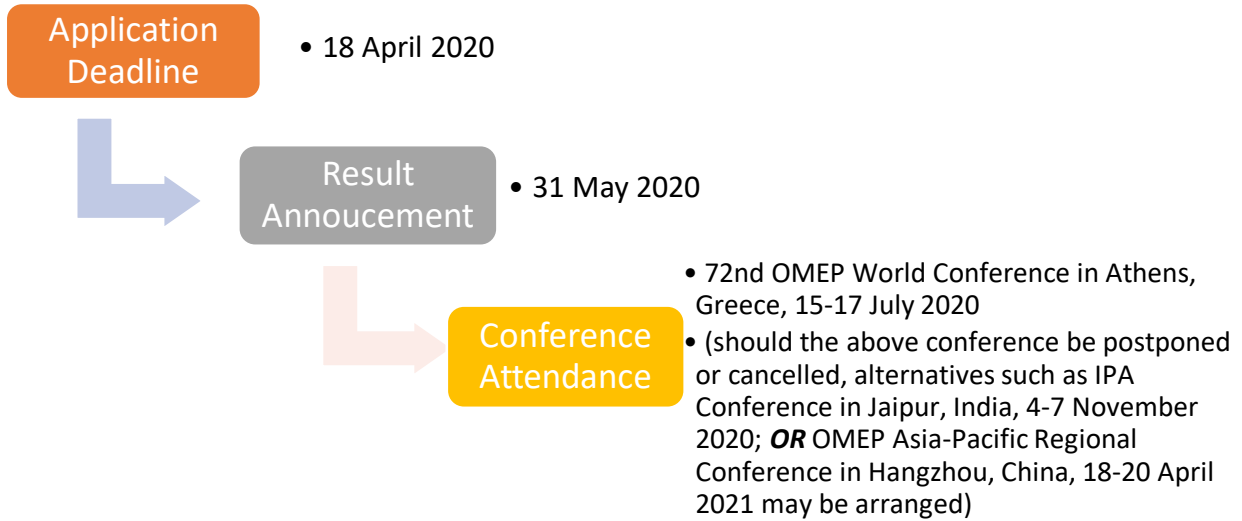
